Dear Rev. Marshall:

Thank you very much for the information you have shared with us on the Marshall geneology. This is something I have been very interested in but have not taken the time to do the necessary research. You have done a great deal of work on this and I know each and every Marshall involved appreciate your fine efforts. I for one appreciate it greatly.

In answer to your questions about the William Frederick Marshall Bible. The following is the only information recorded in it. I hope it will be of some value to your continued research.

Children of William Frederick Marshall and Narcissus M. London Marshall. (Narcissus's nick name was Perk)

1. Mary Bertha Marshall was born Feb. 1, 1883, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa.
2. Lloyd London Marshall was born Dec. 3, 1884, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa. (this is my Grandfather from Clarion)
3. Ethel May Marshall was born March 22, 1887, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa.
4. Netter Belle Marshall was born Sept. 23, 1888, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa.
5. Cresson La Maone Marshall was born July 23, 1896, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa.
6. Frederick Muller Marshall was born Oct. 15, 1898, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pa.

The following deaths as recorded in the Bible.

1. Ethel May Marshall died Oct 13, 1891, Reynoldsville, Pa., of diptheria and croup.
2. Netter Belle Marshall died Oct. 17, 1891, Reynoldsville, Pa., of diptheria and croup.
3. Narcissus M. London (Perk) Marshall, wife of William Frederick Marshall, born near Reynoldsville, Pa., April 14, 1865, died July 11, 1942, at Knox, Pa.
4. William Frederick Marshall, husband of Narcissus M. London (Perk) Marshall, born at Lanes Mills, Pa., Oct. 22, 1864, died April 4, 1945, at Knox, Pa. Interment, Reynoldsville, Pa.
5. Lloyd London Marshall, died Jan. 3, 1953 at the Tuberculosis Leage Hospital, Pittsburg, Pa. Interment, Clarion, Pa.
6. Mary Bertha Marshall, wife of Raymond Evans, 2nd husband. Her first husband was Henry Clayson. Died Dec. 20, 1966, at Clarion, Pa. Interment at Mt. Hope, Pittsburgh, Pa.

7. Frederick Muller Marshall, died Jan. 16, 1974, Maple Avenue Hospital, DuBois, Pa. This is all the information in the Bible other than two or three pictures, a newspaper clipping or two and a pressed flower. The pictures are not identified.

You mentioned some original papers beginning in 1792. I would appreciate it very much if you would share copies of these with me along with any other info you may have no matter how trivial.

In reference to Andersonville, Ga. I have taken the following from the records there and am enclosing copy of info from the Pennsylvania Archives in reference to a Henry L. Marshall.

1. Henry L. Marshall, Pvt. Co. A, 184th Pa. Inf. Died Oct. 23, 1864, of Scorbustus. Grave number at Andersonville is Sect. H, number 11326.
2. Henry M. Marshall, Pvt. Co. E. 78th Pa. Inf. Died June 8, 1864. Cause of death, diarrhea. Grave number 1722, Sect. K.
3. John Marshall, Sr. Pvt. Co. I, 5th Ky. Inf. Died May 19, 1864, of diarrhea. Grave number 1222, Sect. K.

There are several other Marshalls listed but not from Pa. If you need any info on other possibilities of Marshall ancestry that may have been imprisoned in Andersonville, let me know as I am in that area every other week. I visited the graves of the above three men. It saddens me to envision the hardships these and others endured before their deaths in 1864.

Thank you again for the good information you sent to me. Please let me know when and where this years family reunion is to be held. Be sure and contact us if you ever pass this way. One other thing. I have a good friend in Reynoldsville, Eugene Smith. He has the Smith Funeral Home there. If your paths should cross, please tell him hello for me. Thank you.
